Available in many different specialized types such as aerial hoists, scissor lift trucks, and knuckle boom lifts, each model functions very specifically.

The familiar aerial lift adaptation is normally used at ski lodges to transport people who are not at ease using the snowboard lift. Effective in a manner analogous to that of an elevator, snowboarders are transported up the mountain in stages, stopping at stations along the way until they access the summit. Aerial hoists are also used in construction, moving workers safely up and down the sides of multi-level construction sites.

Scissor hoists are also in the boom lift category. They are utilized normally by utility providers as an ideal way to allow staff to finish maintenance and repair on wires and cables that are attached to poles. Phone, cable and power providers have relied on the proficiency of this type of boom lift for years.

Knuckle boom vehicles are built to be utilized in coarse terrain locales where the need to be able to reverse course is necessary. This style of boom can fit into many tight spaces that a scissor lift cannot. Working between numerous equipment in a production facility or in close proximity stuck between two walls, the knuckle boom additionally features a standard table equipped with rails for security and employee safety.
