Course materials include load exercises and load charts for the crane with which the person training is working.

Over half of the course comprises Hands-On Safety Training. Practical training is helpful for developing and increasing personnel skills levels. Just experienced journeyman crane instructors are selected to teach the courses. Our instructors possess numerous years of practice in the industry.

Optional testing mechanisms are offered for all of our courses. Students will usually write tests both before and after training. A test for skills is generally administered for programs that comprise H.O.S.T. Individuals training will be graded and tested.
