The in-depth training which follows particular machinery is required because a lot of the work takes place in dangerous scenarios and hazardous scenes so the operator must be able to ensure a safe working environment at all times. The safety training is vital together with the communications training that helps the group on the ground be able to always communicate with the operator.

Heavy equipment machines often work in extreme settings and are put under great strain regularly. Hence, there are many heavy machine jobs available in repair and maintenance. Heavy equipment operators are highly trained workers who could diagnose, troubleshoot and repair heavy machinery in a work shop or on site. Mechanics should be available to transport their tools to a job site and carry out maintenance and repair in various surroundings.

It might be possible for delivery drivers to acquire work with only a CDL, even though for several jobs, specific endorsements may be needed. For instance, delivering large pieces of machines or components that are really large for building projects would require the driver to complete further training to haul and handle oversize loads. Usually, the drivers operate together with chaperone vehicles which are driven by trained drivers. These chaperone vehicles usually escort the delivery truck to its destination.
