Counterbalance Forklift License Barrie - When operated by fully trained operators, forklifts can become a major asset for firms and companies. Procedures regarding the general operation of the forklift is taught, in addition to startup, circle checks, shutdown, forward/reverse on level ground, and operating around other people. Load handling topics consist of selection of loads, load pickup and placements, loading and off-loading trailers and load security and integrity. Individuals participating would learn operational maintenance procedures, like recharging and refueling. Workplace safety concerns will be discussed. Participants will know the environmental conditions affecting the performance of the lift truck and be able to recognize potential dangers. Advanced training on propane handling can be incorporated.

Employers and their employees may face penalties if they do not operate according to industry and national standards. Employees operating a counterbalance forklift will have to be knowledgeable about the safe operation guidelines of their forklift. Training is recommended for any individual applying for a job which needs forklift operation.
